Founded in 1942, the Canadian Institute of Management is a chartered professional association, certification body and academic institute for managers and leaders. The Institute operates through 16 chapters across Canada and has provided management development and certification to over 80,000 managers since its founding.

The Institute offers two well-recognized professional designations and an academic program.

Certified in Management (C.I.M.)

Graduates of a Nationally Accredited Program are eligible to apply for the C.I.M. designation after 24 months of professional-level management experience or completion of the Management Aptitude Evaluation (MAE).

Chartered Manager (C.Mgr.)

Those with an undergraduate degree in management, supplemented with 48 months of professional-level management experience and completion of the Management Aptitude Evaluation (MAE) are eligible to obtain the C.Mgr. Designation.



Are You a Graduate of a Nationally Accredited Program?

Take the next step and obtain your Certified in Management designation.

If you have graduated from a program that has been accredited, you have completed the academic requirements for the C.I.M designation and do not need to complete any additional coursework! You will receive the right to use “C.I.M” after your name after completing the steps below. The C.I.M. designation tells people that you have met the academic and professional management and leadership requirements that will give you a competitive advantage when you start your management career.

Graduating Soon?

Achieve your C.I.M Designation Today!

Graduates of Nationally Accredited Programs can receive their C.I.M designation through one of two routes:

1. Obtaining 24 months of professional-level management experience, or
2. Successfully passing the online Management Aptitude Evaluation (MAE)

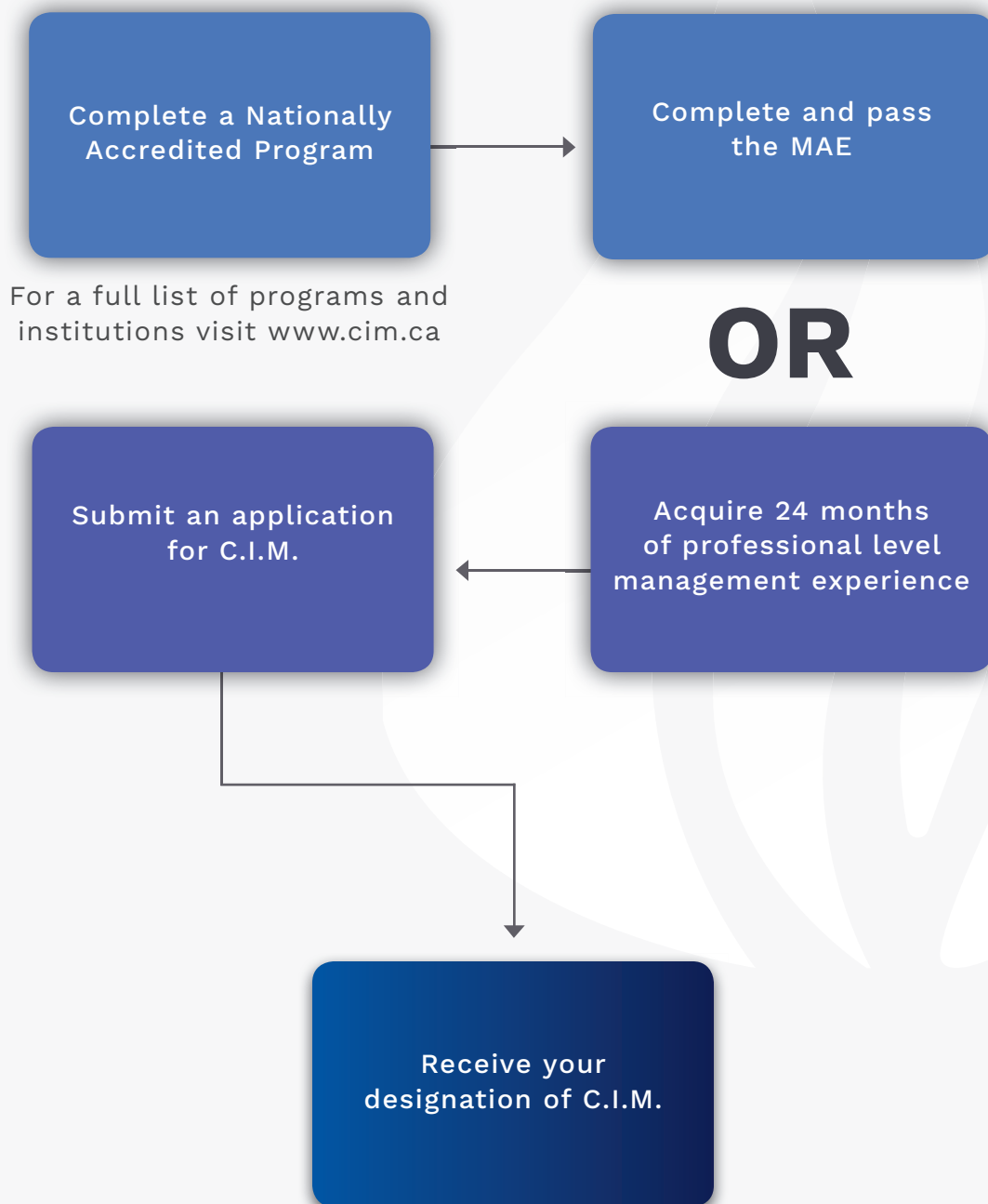
Since you're probably eager to receive your designation and get started right away in your management career, you can register to complete your MAE at any time.

To be granted the C.I.M. designation, candidates are required to submit an application, two letters of reference and a current resume within six (6) years of completing the prescribed studies. Persons holding the C.I.M. designation are required to maintain their membership in good standing with the Institute.

1. Increase your employment potential with a nationally recognized designation proving your management skills
2. Build career excellence with transferable knowledge, skills and competencies
3. Participate in social activities and networking opportunities offered by the Canadian Institute of Management
4. Opportunities for life-long learning, mentorship programs and professional development
5. Pathway to professional employment and better career opportunities with a distinctive designation in management

How to Obtain your C.I.M. Designation



Management Aptitude Evaluation (MAE)

The MAE assesses an individual's ability to lead and manage others

Evaluation Criteria

Candidates must demonstrate their proficiencies in problem-solving, decision-making, interpersonal skills, critical thinking, and learning.

Duration

The MAE can be submitted as many times as is required to achieve a successful outcome. However, a period of 30 days must elapse between evaluations to allow sufficient time for professional development.

Scoring

An average overall score of 60% is required to become registered as Certified in Management (C.I.M). A score of less than 60% in individual areas are acceptable. However, this is a professional development opportunity.

What's Next After I Become Registered as C.I.M.?

Become a Chartered Manager, an internationally recognized designation in management and leadership.

Once registered as C.I.M., students may wish to pursue the Chartered Manager (C.Mgr.) designation. C.Mgr. combines rigorous business education with professional-level experience, setting you apart to contribute to Canada's economic success.

Accounting

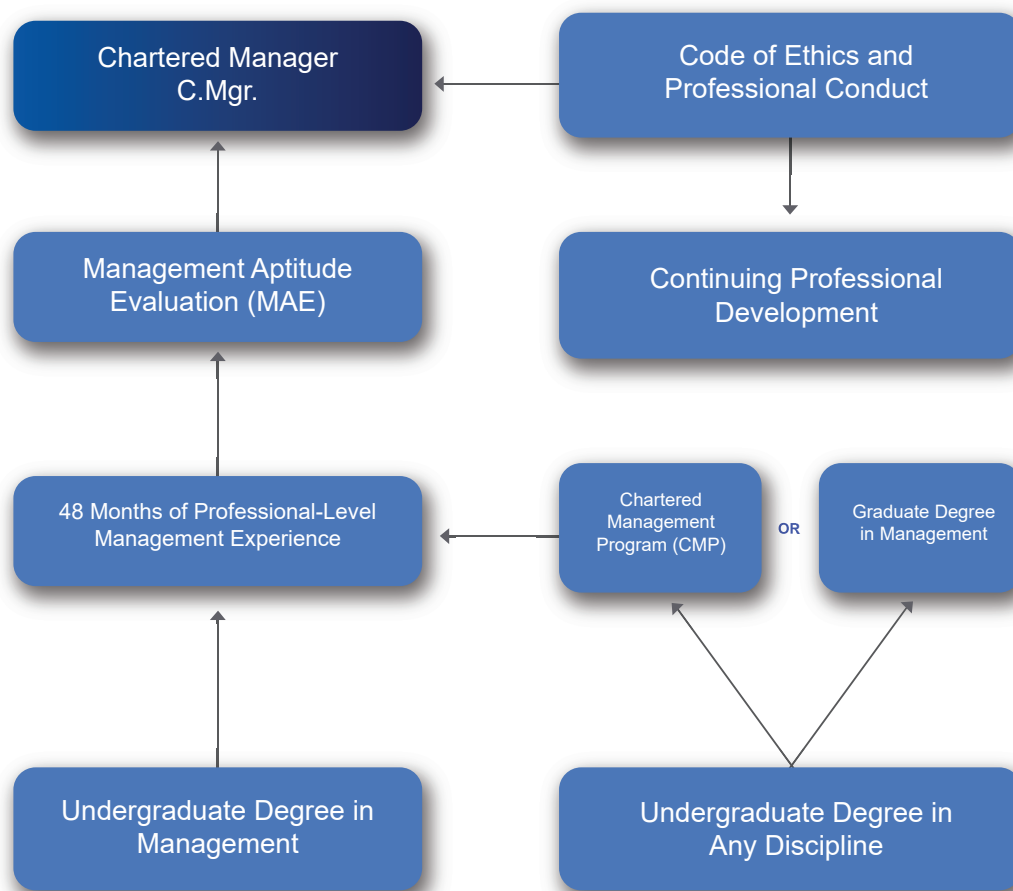

If you have obtained the C.I.M. designation upon graduation, you will need to hold a recognized undergraduate degree in any discipline and complete an additional 48 months of professional-level management experience as well as agree to be bound by the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct.
