TIPS FOR PREPARING FOR A VIDEO INTERVIEW

Video job interviews are a common part of the hiring process, so it is important that you familiarize yourself with the process to ensure you're ready.

CHECK YOUR TECH

Run a video & sound check to ensure your microphone, camera and speakers are working.

GATHER YOUR RESOURCES

Make sure you have a copy of your resume, the job description and any notes you may want to reference.

PRACTISE, PRACTISE, PRACTISE!

Practise a few days in advance so that you are well prepared for the interview.



FIND OPTIMAL CAMERA ANGLE & LIGHTING

The camera should be at eye-level so you look directly into it when you speak, and the room you're in should be well lit so that the interviewer can see you.

PREP YOUR SURROUNDINGS

Make sure the room you are in is neat and attractive.
Avoid doing the interview in your bedroom or in a noisy or distracting area.

DRESS TO IMPRESS

Even though you are not interviewing in person, your appearance still matters.
