About the award

These experiences will be awarded to undergraduate students in the Faculties of Science and Engineering who express an interest in pursuing a nuclear-related summer research work experience with a faculty member at McMaster.

Eligibility criteria

- be a current full-time student in Level 2, 3, or 4 of an Undergraduate Program in the Faculty of Engineering or the Faculty of Science at McMaster University;
- have a minimum cGPA of B;
- have been registered at the time of application in at least one of the two terms immediately before holding the award.
